

# Fact sheet: Application for a research project in the STCS

### Who can apply?

- Any interested researcher
- It is advisable to discuss the project with an STCS investigator to ensure feasibility, and learn about the submission process<sup>1</sup>
- Ideally, the study should take advantage of the multicenter character of the STCS

# What kind of projects are supported by the STCS?

Any research project that uses data and/or samples generated within STCS. Following types of project are eligible:

- Nested projects that make use of preexisting STCS data/infrastructure with or without samples
- Nested projects that make use of the STCS data/infrastructure but require collection of additional data with or without samples
- Investigational trials that make use of STCS data/infrastructure
- International collaborations<sup>2</sup>
- Monocentric studies<sup>2</sup> (multicenter studies are preferred)
- BSc/ MSc/ MD thesis<sup>2</sup>
- Amendments of existing STCS projects<sup>2</sup>

### How much funding can be provided?

• Since 2021, no additional funding from the STCS is available. The STCS however provides high quality data, samples and networks in place to guarantee a successful outcome of the research proposal.

# How are proposals submitted?

- 2-step submission for regular projects<sup>1</sup>:
  - 1. Letter of Intent (LoI) (max. 2 pages)<sup>2</sup>
  - 2. In case of positive decision on the LoI by the STCS Scientific Committee: Submission of Full proposal (FUP)<sup>2</sup>
- Submission deadline 4 times per year, published on www.stcs.ch.

#### How are proposals evaluated?

- Review of the FUP by two experts and one statistician of the STCS Scientific committee (SC)<sup>2</sup>
- Panel discussion with presence of the Principle investigator at STCS SC meeting
- Decision (approval, approval with minor revisions, major revisions, rejection)

#### Progress report and publication

- The project starts with receipt of the acceptance letter
- Submit progress report 18 months after acceptance<sup>2</sup>
- Publication of the project, respecting publication rules, is considered as final report
- A lay summary of each publication has to be submitted to the STCS
